- 70% of all D's and F's go to boys, but only 40 % of the A's.
- Boys have fallen behind girls from preschool through graduate school.
- Boys are four times as likely to be suspended or expelled from early childhood and K-12 environments than girls.
- 85% of stimulant-addressing medications (like Ritalin) are prescribed to U.S. boys.
- Over the last 20+ years, the reading skills of the average 17-year-old boy have declined.
- Boys are farther behind girls in reading than girls are behind boys in science and math.
- Boys are twice as likely as girls to be diagnosed with a behavioral or learning disorder.
